Certificate in Synagogue Executive Leadership (CSEL)

Program modules will be organized around three themes:

- ► Maintaining the Mishkan: Strategic Budgeting & Management
- ► Panim al Panim: Executive Leadership & People Management





CSEL (Cont.)

Participants who complete this program will gain:

- Advanced non-profit training combining Jewish wisdom with real world strategy
- Skills tailored for synagogue executives, taught in a hybrid format
- ► A supportive peer network of synagogue leaders with opportunities to leverage each other's talents, resources, and support
- ► A nationally recognized credential offering leadership and expertise





CSEL Program Components

- November 16-17, 2025
 - ► In-person immediately preceding the NATA Conference in Tucson, AZ
- ► January March 2026
 - > Synchronous, online sessions on Tuesday evenings (Several weekly sessions, 2 hours each)
- ► April 26-29, 2026
 - ► In-person concurrent with NATA meetings at Spertus in Chicago, IL





Application Logistics

Application Dates

- ► September 10 Priority Application Deadline
- ► September 30 Final Application Deadline
- ► Interviews throughout September and October

Cost

- ► Program Cost: \$4,000
- ► Participant Responsibility: \$1,500 for the first cohort
 - Includes tuition, materials, technology, and all meals during the program.
 - ► Participants will be responsible for airfare and hotel costs for the in-person sessions.





Applications

- ► A bachelor's degree or the equivalent
- ▶ 5 years of professional experience
- ► The ability to do graduate-level academic work
- ► A strong commitment to developing and fulfilling their professional potential
- Active regular or associate NATA Membership for 2025-2026 program year
